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Policy

In accordance with individual Committee Terms of Reference, the Board of Directors may appoint up to two (2) additional members who are not Directors to the Quality/Governance & Planning Committee and the Resources & Audit Committee of the Board. Those persons shall be entitled to vote.

The Nominating Sub-Committee of the Quality/Governance & Planning Committee is responsible for recommending to the Board of Directors the appointment of Community Representatives.

Responsibilities

In fulfilling the role and responsibilities of a Community Representative on Board Standing Committees, Committee members are required to adhere to the same requirements as a member of the Board of Directors. In addition to the responsibilities outlined in individual Committee Terms of Reference and in the Hospital's Code of Conduct, members shall:

- (a) adhere to the Hospital's Mission, Vision and Values;
- (b) keep informed about:
 - (i) matters relating to the Corporation
 - (ii) the community served, and
 - (iii) other health care services provided in the region; and
- (c) participate in the initial orientation as a new Committee member, and in any ongoing educational opportunities.

Tenure

The tenure for Community Representatives shall be a two-year term, with the potential of a second two-year term.
