### RMH After Hours Clinic Moving Locations...

As of **June 29<sup>th</sup> 2005**, the Ross Memorial Hospital After Hours Clinic has moved to a location within the Hospital, in the new Ambulatory Care Centre facing Kent Street.

This new location provides physicians and patients with better access to diagnostic equipment and hospital services.

Patients are asked to enter off Kent Street, where they have access to short term parking adjacent to the clinic. This entrance allows for more convenient access for patients without them needing to travel throughout the hospital.

The previous after hours clinic location at 280 Kent Street will therefore be closed.

### Giving the Gift that Lasts... Endowment Funds

An endowment is an investment fund set aside to provide a source of long-term support for a charitable organization, such as the Ross Memorial Hospital Foundation (RMHF).

With an endowment, only the investment income earned, or a portion of the income, is disbursed, while the principal remains intact.

For RMHF, Endowment Funds produce a reliable source of income to address a continuing need. They are generally held in perpetuity, which means that they will be invested to sustain the hospital for generations to come.

An named endowment to RMHF can be started with a minimum capital gift of \$50,000 and additional contributions to the fund can be made during the donor's lifetime and beyond. All donors have the option of contributing to a number of established endowment funds that support a variety of programs.

Endowment gifts are most commonly made in the form of cash and marketable securities. Gifts of real estate, personal property, life insurance, and gifts resulting from provisions in a will (bequests) can also be used to fund an endowment.
