The City of Kawartha Lakes is a charming mix of rural communities and urban centers located in the heart of cottage country. Located one hour north-east of the Greater Toronto Area (GTA), the City is the "gateway" to the Kawartha Lakes region, one of Canada's favorite vacation destinations.

The major points of access include: Trans Canada Hwy 7, Provincial Hwy 35, Kawartha Lakes Rd. 48, the Trent-Severn Waterway and the Kawartha Lakes Municipal Airport.
